ACCU is seeking to recruit an Advocacy Officer with the following responsibilities;

- Identify and plan for advocacy needs of the organization.
- Undertake research or coordinate research teams to mobilize and analyze appropriate information for enhancing the awareness and advocacy role of ACCU.
- Regularly identify, package and plan to disseminate information on Advocacy issues and study results arising out of the project intervention through the media and other relevant platforms.
- Plan, design and implement the advocacy strategy and campaigns for ACCU.
- Establish, maintain and coordinate strong links and working relationships with relevant government ministries and departments, parliament, NGO partners, and other relevant institutions on priority issues.
- Ensure the visibility of ACCU and her work at all levels.
- Monitor, identify and articulate key issues, trends, policies and practices on corruption as well as lobby appropriate government agencies to act on the reported or exposed cases of corruption.
- Ensure efficient, effective and timely implementation of research and advocacy activities as per the work-plans.
- Work with the Head of Programmes to respond and address donor requirements of projects.
- Offer support in the mobilization of resources for the programmes of the organization through the development of relevant proposals and undertaking any other relevant resource mobilization activities.

Spearhead the implementation (planning, organising, controlling and reporting) of research and advocacy interventions for the Strengthening Partnership for Anti-Corruption, Responsiveness and Civic Engagement (SPARC) project.

Relevant Skills and Experience include;
